

Seasonal update

2022 has begun and it looks as though we are heading into another positive year of growth for the Australian livestock industry.

A combination of continued global demand for meat and a tightening of supply across Australian livestock markets, due to restocker activity and flock rebuilding, means that livestock prices are likely to remain high. With such a positive outlook for the industry, now is the time to invest in maximising production and profitability through targeted supplementation!

Why supplement year round?

Micro nutrient deficiency is not always acutely visible in your herd or flock. Unlike energy/protein undernourishment, which is easily spotted, it is the health impacts of micro nutrient deficiency that can undermine the performance and profitability of your entire livestock operation.

Avoiding deficiency is particularly important when livestock are experiencing higher physiological requirements such as during pregnancy and lactation.

Providing livestock with **year round** access to quality vitamin and mineral supplementation, that meets their needs, will ensure optimal growth, development and reproductive performance throughout the life of these animals and future generations to follow.

"Focus on Phosphorus"

Vital for almost every function of the body

Low soil phosphorus is a big issue for producers in WA's northern pastoral region. New research has identified areas in southern WA that also suffer from low soil phosphorus.

When animals can't absorb enough phosphorus through their diet, production losses such as retarded growth rates, low milk yield and reduced fertility become evident.

These losses can be prevented. Provide livestock with free access to phosphorus supplement such as the MFS 8% Phos block

What to feed now - Pastoral Region

Production 20 Block

A high protein cattle block with 20% urea, moderate phosphorus levels and essential micro minerals.

Promotes fibre digestion of poor or dry pastures. Builds a robust animal with a strong hoof horn which is more willing to breed and travel for food and water.

Will increase weight gains in dry cows or steers and milk yield in lactating cows.



Dry Phos 10 Block

5% Phos + 10% Urea

With protein meal and urea as the source of protein and nitrogen, the additional high sulphur and magnesium inclusion will assist with live weight gains.



Also recommend -

- Production Lick 8% Urea Plus Phosphorus
- Production Lick 10% Urea Plus Phosphorus
- WA Northern Breeder Dry Season Licks - 20%, 25% and 30% Urea. Formulations available.



What to feed now - Southern Agricultural Region



Maintain Mineral Block

Suitable for sheep, cattle and goats all year round. Containing 17.5% Calcium, 1.5% Phosphorus, 1.06% Magnesium, 0.30% Potassium, 1.16% Sulphur, 26.5% Salt (NA), 3.5% Molasses, zinc, copper, manganese, selenium, cobalt, iodine Vitamin A, D3, E, B7 (Biotin) and 25-hydroxycholecalciferol.



Summer Dry Feed Block 10% Urea

Encourages stock to forage for and fully utilize available dry feed. Suitable for sheep & cattle. Contains 10% Urea, 3.5% Molasses, 15% Calcium, 3.44% Phosphorus, 2.22% Sulphur, 1.13% Magnesium, 24% Salt (NaCl), 1.25% Crude Fat (EE), zinc, manganese, copper, iodine, cobalt and selenium.
